Approval of the Police Lieutenant Eligibility List Dated March 12, 2014

As Subject Matter Expert, Interim Commander Taylor gave a brief presentation to the Commission of the City's Lieutenant Assessment Center process held on March 4, 2014. The Assessment Center was facilitated by Jon Walters and Robbie Berg of Public Safety Testing. Chief Examiner Edin was present to observe the process. Candidates at the Assessment Center participated in four exercises. The four exercises included: 1. A Structured Interview with Oral Summation; 2. A Citizen Employee Couplet and Writing Summation; 3. An In-Basket with Oral Presentation; and 4. A Lieutenant's Unit Meeting. Chief Examiner Edin reported that six candidate originally applied to attend the Assessment Center. One candidate dropped out at the last minute due to family issues. Of the five candidates who participated, three passed the assessment center.
