Approval of Minutes: Moved by Commissioner Cruickshank, seconded by Commissioner Forbis, to approve the minutes of the April 22, 2015 meeting. Motion carried (7-0-0-0).

Movie in the Park: There was no additional discussion on this agenda item.

Shakespeare and Music on the Lake: Commissioner Tietze reported the Arts & Parks Foundation has received \$2500 in donations, and also that radio station KRKO will be doing commercials for the upcoming Music on the Lake. Advertising is in process for these summer events.

MOTION: Moved by Commissioner Forbis, seconded by Commissioner Holz, to allow sponsors to promote Music on the Lake in their literature. Motion carried (6-0-0-1).

Roundabout Art: Commissioner Forbis reported that she is continuing to work with City Administrator Berg to bring the Commissions' recommendation for new art in the roundabout to Council.


Art Rotation: Art rotation was discussed. There was consensus to explore ways to bring more notoriety to artists who display their work in City offices. One way might be to have a picture of the artist and their work and a short article in the newspaper.

Scholarship: Nine scholarship applications were received. Scholarship applications were reviewed. Scholarships will be awarded on May 27 at the Lake Stevens Performing Arts Center.

MOTION by Commissioner Hinchcliffe, second by Commissioner Cruickshank, to award a first place scholarship to Khan Paprakhan, and a runner-up scholarship to Sarah Camp, each in the amount of \$500. Motion carried (7-0-0-0).
