- Advertising, for vendors and for the market.

Music on the Lake (Martin Reimers, chair)

Sponsors who wish to support Music on the Lake can receive tax credits as monies collected go to the Arts Foundation.

Shakespeare in the Park will be advertised as a special presentation of Music on the Lake on July 12th.

LSAC listened to several bands that submitted CDs to be considered for this summer's schedule.

The Navy Band will only book 6 weeks in advance, LSAC is unsure if they will be on the schedule at this time.

LASC will begin to have meetings twice a month at this time.
