PROPOSED ORDINANCE – AUTOMATED TRAFFIC SAFETY CAMERAS**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Lake Stevens City Council will hold a **public hearing** on **Tuesday, July 1, 2025, at approximately 6:00 PM**, or as soon thereafter as the matter may be heard, during its regular City Council meeting held at:

The purpose of the hearing is to receive public comment and consider the adoption of an ordinance that would add a new Chapter 7.06 to the Lake Stevens Municipal Code establishing an **Automated Traffic Safety Camera Program**. The proposed ordinance would:

- Authorize the use of traffic safety cameras in school zones, work zones, high-crash areas, and other designated zones.
- Set policies for infraction issuance, penalty structure, data privacy, vendor contracts, and equity-based site analysis.
- Require annual public reporting and direct camera revenue to traffic safety and equity-based improvements.
