

SMP Periodic Update Overview

Lake Stevens Shoreline Master Program (SMP)


- An SMP is a comprehensive shoreline land-use plan that includes policies and regulations for the use and development of the shoreline
- Shorelines in Lake Stevens include Lake Stevens, Stitch Lake, portions of Little Pilchuck Creek, and Catherine Creek
- Supports regulation of critical areas within shoreline jurisdiction

Lake Stevens is updating its SMP to:

- Address recent amendments to state laws and guidance
- Ensure consistency with other City plans and regulations

This periodic update of the SMP will not:

- Re-evaluate the ecological baseline that was established as part of the 2013 comprehensive SMP update
- Extensively assess no net loss criteria other than to ensure that proposed amendments do not result in degradation of the baseline condition
- Change shoreline jurisdiction
