



## **APPLICATIONS REQUESTED FOR APPOINTMENT TO VETERANS COMMISSION**

The City is requesting applications from persons interested in appointment to fill two vacancies on the Veterans Commission. The Veterans Commission represents the U.S. military veteran constituency in the Lake Stevens community and works to provide support and opportunities to veterans and their families within the community. The Veterans Commission is comprised of eleven members, consisting of three Lake Stevens City Council members and eight members who are residents of Lake Stevens and/or the Lake Stevens Urban Growth Area. At least two of the eight members have actively served in the U.S. Military Service. Vacancies and terms are described below:

- Position 5 – 3 years, term expires December 31, 2021
- Position 8 – Unexpired term ending December 31, 2019

Commissioners may request reappointment to the Veterans Commission at the end of their appointed term by submitting a written request for reappointment to the Mayor.
