REQUIREMENTS:

All applicants must have a valid Washington driver's license, proof of U.S. citizenship and no felony convictions.

- Must successfully pass background check, polygraph, psychological and medical exams
- Must successfully complete Field training and probationary period.

EDUCATION

- High School Diploma or equivalent (e.g., G.E.D.)
- Prefer a minimum of 45 quarter or 30 semester college credits towards a relevant college degree

EXPERIENCE

- Entry Level: No previous law enforcement experience needed
- Lateral:
 - Currently employed, or has been employed within the last 24 months as a full-time, law enforcement officer with a city, county, state, or federal agency
 - Successfully completed past agency's Field Training program;
 - Successfully completed the Washington Basic Law Enforcement Academy or Prior training qualifies candidate to attend the Washington Basic Law Enforcement Equivalency Academy

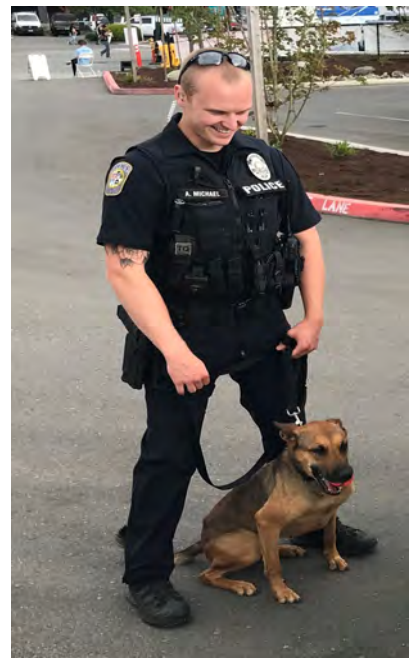
